

PERSONAL SOCIAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION POLICY (PSHE)

As part of the pastoral care programme and inclusive in much of the curriculum and many of our after school activities, PSHE is implicit in much of what we do at Park House English School. As a school we are committed to fostering an atmosphere of trust and respect and instilling in our students an ethos of understanding and sensitivity towards all members of the school community, fostering a lifelong commitment to these attitudes.

The aim of our PSHE approach is to prepare all our students to become successful, caring and morally upright members of the international community. In the Primary Department, most PSHE targets are embedded in the IPC (International Primary Curriculum), though some targets are met in Science, Literacy and Numeracy. PSHE is very often the focus of Assemblies. In the Secondary Department PSHE is delivered in several areas of the curriculum and through Form Tutors and Assemblies.

The school is aware of the cultural and religious sensitivities of many of the students and staff and the PSHE approach reflects these sensitivities and expectations.
